## CLOSED-END MUNICIPAL BOND FUND RESOURCES

In his article on closed-end municipal bond funds in this issue (page 18), Albert Fredman suggests that research reports on these instruments can be obtained from select brokerage firms that cover them. However, if you don't already have a relationship with one of these brokers, you will need to find alternative sources of information. The following list should help.

Current net asset value, price, discount or premium, and yield can be easily tracked each week in Barron's or the Wall Street Journal. For more in-depth historical performance data, Morningstar and Standard & Poor's offer printed and computer resources, some of which may be carried in your local library.

A few Web sites are listed in the

second section for computer users. Since closed-end funds are exchange-traded, think of them more as stocks than funds when searching for information either on-line or in a library.

The last section lists two advisory newsletters that report and make recommendations on closed-end funds.
