## SMALL COMPANY STOCKS

Locating smaller companies can be difficult. Many company directories do not go beyond the large, established firms. Finding financial information on these firms can also be a challenge. Where should you focus your search efforts?

For company addresses and phone

numbers, try the directories listed in the first section below. Once you track down this information, you can call the company directly to request a copy of their most recent annual report and 10-K statement.

For detailed financial data, the sources in the second section below may report on the small company that interests you. Most of these will be available at your local public library.
