You may already own your suggested security or it may be a transaction you are thinking about. [We expect you to back your idea just like Elon Musk backs his... with other people's money.] Though our contest has a one-year time horizon, we welcome ideas that have shorter or longer shelf life. You can always claim victory by saying your time horizon was whatever time span your investment had gains.

If possible, please bring copies of a data sheet or a research article that was useful in your decision making to hand out to other attendees so they can fully appreciate your analytical genius. [20 copies preferred].

During 31 years of practice, Alan has published a stock market advisory letter, managed stock and bond assets of \$60 million, led monthly meetings of AAll-Chicago groups, served as Vice President of the AAll-Chicago Board, and lectured across the country on investment topics.

In 2011, Liebman moved American Superior Company to Reno, Nevada where he continues to serve high-net-worth clients in six states and to help all investors make more informed choices.
