Date and Time: Thursday, July 10, 2014, 7 to 9 p.m.

Presentation Title and Synopsis:

Using Technical Analysis to Make Buy and Sell Decisions

In response to your requests, our July program will focus on Technical Analysis ... the method of analyzing securities using market statistics, such as price and trading volume changes. Reno-AAll member Perry Levy will give us a basic introduction to technical analysis, then explain how he uses this approach to compute appropriate prices at which securities can be profitably bought and sold.

Levy bases his analysis method on a study of more than 110 years of Dow Jones Industrial Average data. His techniques can be applied to any equity security that has at least 10 years of market history and 100 million shares outstanding. Levy's method is not entirely focused on price movements; he also looks at such financial parameters as book value and five-year price-earnings ratio in making his conclusions.

The Levy analysis method was designed for investors who hold securities less than one month, but it has applicability to shorter and longer holding periods too. Perry will show us examples of the model's past successes and some of its predictions of future opportunities.
