Presentation Title and Synopsis:

Public Companies in Reno -- What's hot and not?

When International Game Technology is absorbed into GTECH later this Spring, the headquarters location of Reno's most valuable, publicly traded company will fade into history, even though the IGT name will survive the merger.

But that merger doesn't mean Reno has no direct connection to publicly traded companies. There are at least half a dozen other public companies with headquarters or significant satellite offices in Reno. More interesting still are the hundred large, public companies that do business in Reno.

Reno is also home to outlets and facilities run by big, publicly traded gaming companies, technology companies, mining companies and major logistics operations. Many national restaurant and retail store chains do business around town. Supermarkets too. Ditto mall and theater owners. We cannot omit the company du jour... Tesla and its battery buddy Panasonic.

At the March meeting, we'll study the prospects of "Reno-associated" public companies. Can the Biggest Little City point us toward Biggest Profits? *Your assignment for this meeting*, should you choose to accept it, *is to pick one Reno-affiliated public company and tell us all why you recommend it*. Bring 20 handout sheets that describe your selection if possible; your fellow attendees will appreciate that. One Caveat: we will discuss Tesla and Apple Computer as a "group submission" *so you are not allowed to choose either of those companies!* You've got to stretch beyond the obvious to find a Reno gem.

Location: ArrowCreek Residents Center, 2900 Arrowcreek Pkwy, Reno 89511.

Directions: Exit I-580 at Damonte Ranch and go west across Virginia St. Bear left onto Arrowcreek Pkwy and continue west about four miles to the entry gate of the Arrowcreek Community. Tell the guard you are attending the AAll meeting at the Residents Center. Proceed straight 1/2 mile to the first stop sign. Turn right (*downhill*) into the parking lot for the Residents Center. It's a 10 minute drive from I-580 to the Center building. [NOTE: If you arrive at the Arrowcreek *Country Club* by mistake, just go directly back across Arrowcreek Parkway to the *Residents Center*.]

Speaker / Discussion Leader: Alan J. Liebman

During 32 years of practice, Alan has published a stock market advisory letter, managed stock and bond assets of \$60 million, led monthly meetings of AAll-Chicago groups, served as Vice President of the AAll-Chicago Board, and lectured across the country on investment topics.
