Put Your Investing IQ to the Test!

Alan Liebman has been helping investors for more than three decades. He earned a bachelor's degree from Columbia University in physics and a doctorate from Yale in applied physics. Liebman worked in corporate R&D at Xerox Corporation and AT&T for 15 years.

In 1984, Liebman founded American Superior Company in suburban Chicago, a fee-only investment advisory firm. During 33 years of practice, Alan has published a stock market advisory letter, managed stock and bond assets of \$60 million, led monthly meetings of AAll-Chicago groups, served as Vice President of the AAll-Chicago Board, and lectured across the country on investment topics.

In 2011, Liebman moved American Superior Company to Reno, Nevada where he continues to serve high-net-worth clients in six states and to help all investors make more informed choices.
