Presentation Title and Synopsis:

What Can Go Wrong?

Bad news on the airwaves. Mayhem rising. Hands wringing. Spouses sobbing. No, it's not only a falling stock market that can cause sweaty palms, sleepless nights and headaches. Our modern world has created many new monsters that can floor us with a swat of their paws. The internet monster. The computer monster. The password monster. Hackers and hijackers. Speaker / Discussion Leader: Alan J. Liebman
