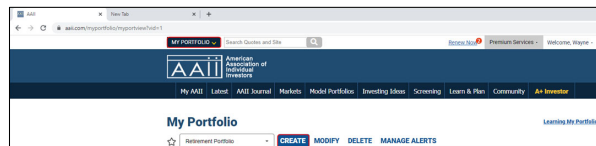
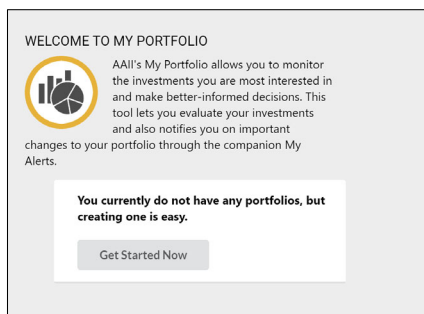
My Portfolio Tool

 - Track performance of your holdings
 - Access in-depth data on stock, mutual fund and ETF holdings
 - Stock, mutual fund and ETF ratings of your holdings
 - Analyze your portfolio to see if it fits your style and temperament
 - Portfolio insights to identify strong and weak holdings
- My Portfolio is not designed to be a full-featured portfolio management system for tracking detailed transaction histories
 - This functionality is offered by most brokerage platforms

The foundation of growth investing is the notion that stocks of companies exhibiting strong, consistent and prolonged growth outperform those of slower-growth companies. Growth has several dimensions, including year-over-year increases in sales and earnings, long(er)-term historical sales and earnings growth rates and analyst-forecasted long-term earnings growth.

The components consider a company's success in growing its sales, earnings per share, and operating cash on a year-over-year basis for the latest reported fiscal quarter and on an annualized basis over the last five years.

The weighted four-quarter relative strength rank is the relative price change for each of the past four quarters. The most recent quarterly price change is given a weight of 40% and each of the three previous quarters given a weighting of 20%.

It is considered to be an anomaly in the analysis of stock returns because stocks with high relative levels of momentum tend to continue to outperform, while stocks with low relative levels of momentum tend to continue underperforming.

Investing based on analyst estimates looks for revisions in the consensus estimates as well as earnings surprises (actual earnings deviating from the consensus estimate). Academic studies have shown that companies that have seen strong upward earnings revisions or have reported significant earnings surprises can see an impact on share prices for up to a year.

The components examine the magnitude of a company's earnings surprises for the last two reported fiscal quarters as well as the change in the consensus estimate for the current fiscal year over the last month and three months.

TSLA has an estimate revisions score of 43, which is Neutral.

The Quality Grade is the percentile rank of the average of the percentile ranks of the return on assets (ROA), return on invested capital (ROIC), gross profit relative to assets, buyback yield, change in total liabilities to assets, accruals, Z Double Prime bankruptcy risk (Z) score and F-Score. The score is variable, meaning it can consider all eight measures or, should any of the eight measures not be valid, the remaining measures that are valid. To be assigned a Quality Score, stocks must have a valid (non-null) measure and corresponding ranking for at least four of the eight quality measures.

The Quality Score is used to assess the "quality" of a particular stock. A higher quality stock possesses traits associated with upside potential and reduced downside risk.

Stocks receive better grades (higher scores) for having higher scores for the quality sub-components and worse grades (lower scores) for lower scores for the sub-components.

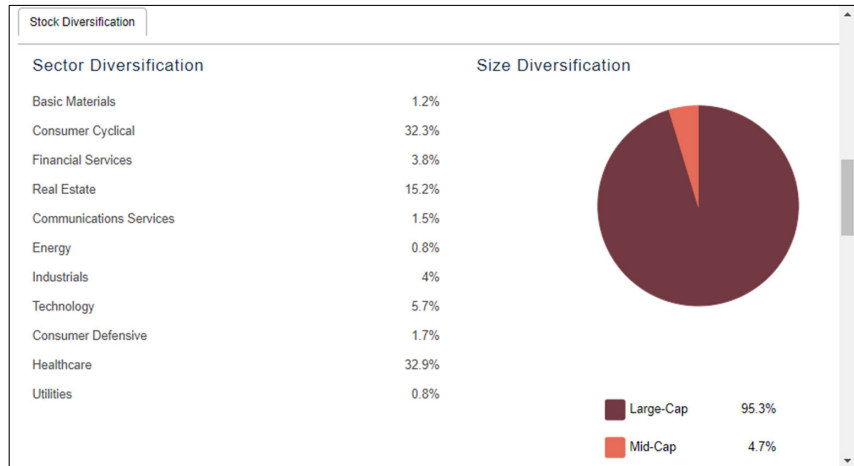

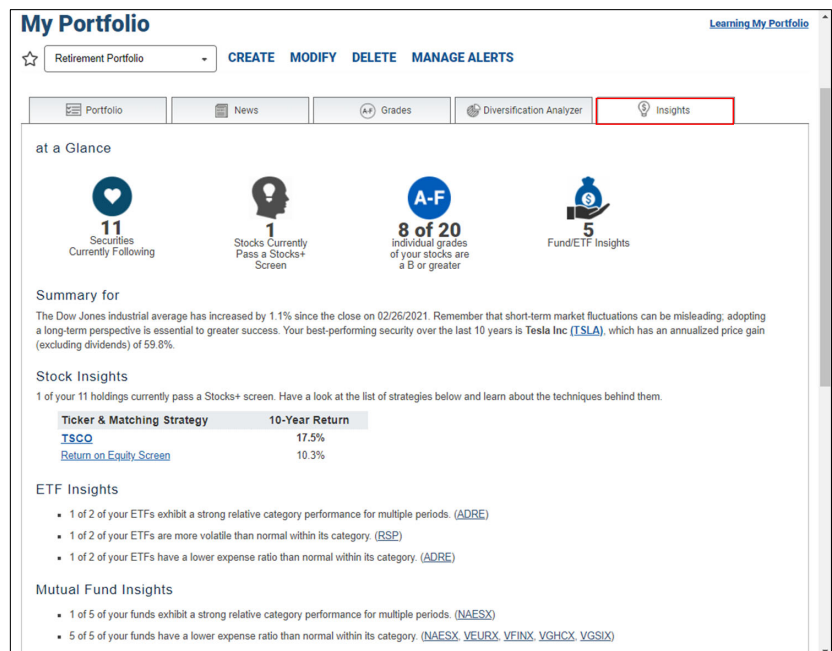


Sector & Size Diversification

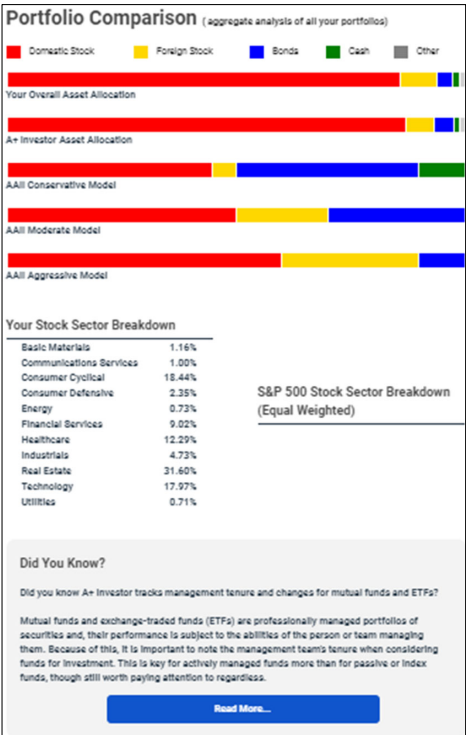
